

**Board Bulletin**  
**From David Bonnette, Interim Superintendent (2009-10)**

The June 23, 2009, regular meeting of the District 208 Board of Education was held at the Brookfield Village Hall. The meeting was called to order by Board President Marciniak at 7:30 p.m.

- The Board adopted a resolution of commendation for Beverlee Wolf for her 53 years of dedicated service to the district.
- John Passarella gave a report on summer school. The summer graduation program will take place on June 25, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. at Hollywood School.
- A citizen addressed the Board on a “Statement of Economic Interest” issue.
- Consent agenda items that were approved included:
  - Approval of June 2, 2009, and June 9, 2009, meeting minutes
  - Payment of bills
  - A prevailing wage resolution
  - The West 40, Regional Safe School program for 2009-10
- Independent study course proposals were presented. No action was taken, pending additional information.
- It was decided not to reinstate a part-time support staff position for the library and instructional technology department.
- Change orders for the building project were approved as presented.
- The tentative budget for the 2009-10 fiscal year was reviewed and approved for public display.
- A transfer of interest monies from the Debt Service Fund to the Education Fund was authorized.
- A first reading of a proposed revision in the Board policy on student residency was conducted.
- A revision in the contract with ARAMARK for facility management services was presented for initial review.
- The Board approved a contract with the Illinois Association of School Boards for ongoing policy manual services.

Following a closed session, the Board acted on the following personnel matters:

1. Appointed Tim Scanlon to the position of principal for the 2009-10 school year.
2. Renewed the contract of Chris Whelton, Business Manager, for 2009-10 and 2010-11.
3. Made adjustments in the contracts of John Passarella and David Sibley for the 2009-10 year.
4. Appointed Troy Gobble to the position of Assistant Principal for Instruction for the 2009-10 year.
5. Approved a salary recommendation for 2009-10 for confidential staff.
6. Approved a consistent level of vacation time for full-year administrative staff.
7. Declared July 3, 2009, as the floating holiday for the 2009-10 year.
8. Accepted Renee Ramsey's resignation as volleyball assistant coach.
9. Made a correction in the salary schedule placement of the newly appointed art teacher.
10. Accepted the resignation of Superintendent Jack Baldermann, effective June 23, 2009.
