

Blood Drive Scholarship for 2011

The Blood Drive Scholarship is an award based upon the grant money from LifeSource Blood Service. This scholarship is intended to assist students who have exhibited outstanding involvement in the RB Blood Drives sponsored by the Student Association, either through their service or donation.

Eligibility and Requirements:

1. The candidate must be a senior at RBHS who will have met the requirements for graduation by June 2011;
2. The candidate must be planning to attend a college or university for the 2011-2012 school year;
3. The candidate must have assisted in the planning of the Blood Drives at RBHS during the 2010-2011 school year OR must have donated blood at the blood drives;
4. The candidate must submit a short essay which includes a personal statement explaining why donating blood is important and how this experience will affect their future. In addition, include the name of the post-secondary school that will be attended, future career plans and reasons for consideration of the scholarship. The candidate should also indicate how he/she will benefit from financial assistance;
5. The application must be accompanied by two recommendation letters from RB teachers or staff members. Do not use a recommendation letter from Ms. Ziola, Mr. Fields, Ms. Nickelson, or Ms. Bernstein.
6. Deadline for applicants is Friday, April 15, 2011. Please return the completed application packet to Student Services.
7. The scholarship will be awarded on Wednesday, May 18, 2011 at the Scholarship Awards Banquet.
