- Any violation after the third offense in Category A will result in a one year suspension from all contests.
- Any violation after the third offense in Category B will result in suspension from contests for the remaining high school career of the athlete.
- When a student violates different categories, the Administration reserves the right to impose a penalty as deemed appropriate to the student's overall record of previous violations. Penalties will be imposed on a cumulative basis within each class; i.e., "A," "B," or "C."
- Punishment per season WILL carry to the next season if not able to be completed during the current season; i.e. 10% of season.
- The carry-over will occur from the spring to fall season of the following year. Training rules are enforced year-round.
- In addition to the above categories, student-athletes will be held responsible to the RBHS school code and IHSA rules. Violation of those rules will result in disciplinary action at the discretion of the Administration.
