Year Eleven at an exclusive prep school in the suburbs of Melbourne, Australia, would be tough enough, but it is further complicated for Amal when she decides to wear the hijab, the Muslim head scarf, full-time as a badge of her faith--without losing her identity or sense of style.

FIC ABDEL-FATTAH      Ten Things I Hate About Me

Lebanese-Australian Jamilah, known in school as Jamie, hides her heritage from her classmates and tries to pass by dyeing her hair blonde and wearing blue-tinted contact lenses, until her conflicted feelings become too much for her to bear.

FIC ATWATER-RHODES   Wyvernhal: The Kiesha'ra series vol. 5

In order to protect the people and the world she loves from the future she sees in increasingly horrific visions, Hai is forced to throw away her own happiness and ascend the serpente throne.

FIC BRYANT              Ringside 1925

Visitors, spectators, and residents of Dayton, Tennessee, in 1925 describe, in a series of free-verse poems, the Scopes "monkey trial" and its effects on that small town and its citizens.

FIC CHILDRESS         Rainbow Jordan

Her mother, her foster guardian, and fourteen-year-old Rainbow comment on the state of things as she prepares to return to a foster home for yet another stay.

FIC CLARKE             Childhood's End

When the Overlords first came to Earth, they brought peace and prosperity with them, but it soon became apparent that their purpose was the elimination of the human race.

FIC DOWD               Bog Child

In 1981, the height of Ireland's "Troubles," eighteen-year-old Fergus is distracted from his upcoming A-level exams by his imprisoned brother's hunger strike, the stress of being a courier for Sinn Fein, and dreams of a murdered girl whose body he discovered in a bog.

FIC FARMER             The Land of the Silver Apples

After escaping from the Sea of Trolls, the apprentice bard Jack plunges into a new series of adventures, traveling underground to Elfland and uncovering the truth about his little sister Lucy.

FIC FRANKLIN          The Other Half of Me

Feeling out of place in her athletic family, artistic sixteen-year-old Jenny Fitzgerald, whose biological father was a sperm donor, finds her half sister through the Sibling Donor Registry and contacts her, hoping that this will make her feel complete.

FIC FREITAS            The Possibilities of Sainthood

While regularly petitioning the Vatican to make her the first living saint, fifteen-year-old Antonia Labella prays to assorted patron saints for everything from help with preparing the family's fig trees for a Rhode Island winter to getting her first kiss from the right boy.

FIC FULL                Full House: 10 Stories about Poker

Contains ten short fiction stories about the game of poker, featuring selections by Francine Pascal, Adam Stemple, and others, and includes a glossary of poker terms.

FIC FUNKE              Inkheart

Twelve-year-old Meggie learns that her father Mo, a bookbinder, can "read" fictional characters to life when an evil ruler named Capricorn, freed from the novel "Inkheart" years earlier, tries to force Mo to release an immortal monster from the story.

FIC GARDNER           The Red Necklace

In the late eighteenth-century, Sido, the twelve-year-old daughter of a self-indulgent marquis, and Yann, a fourteen-year-old Gypsy orphan raised to perform in a magic show, face a common enemy at the start of the French Revolution.

The Flowers

Fifteen-year-old Sonny Bravo moves with his mother and her new husband to an apartment complex called The Flowers where he becomes caught up in the lives of his neighbors, and tries to do what he can to ease the racial tensions that threaten to destroy all of them.

Hallway Diaries

Contains three stories about African-American and biracial teens discovering their own identities while trying to fit in at new schools and in challenging situations.

FIC HALPIN

Forever Changes

Instead of applying to colleges Brianna Pelletier, a mathematically-gifted high school senior with cystic fibrosis, decides to dwell on her own mortality and the unfairness of life until one day she discovers a new kind of math, and her eyes are opened to possibilities.

FIC HATCHER

In His Arms

After thinking she killed her employer while defending herself from him, Mary Malone must get out of New York for the sake of her baby. Landing in Idaho, the Irish native works as a bookkeeper in a saloon. Then Mary's troubles start when the sheriff is drawn to her.

FIC HENDERSON

Kiss Me Kill Me

Longing to be part of the in-crowd at her exclusive London school, orphaned sixteen-year-old Scarlett, a trained gymnast, eagerly accepts an invitation to a party whose disastrous outcome changes her life forever.

FIC HERLONG

The Great Wide Sea

Still mourning the death of their mother, three brothers go with their father on an extended sailing trip off the Florida Keys and have a harrowing adventure at sea.

FIC JACOBS

Choices

Overcome with guilt over her brother's death, a teenaged girl shifts between multiple universes in an attempt to find one in which he is alive.

Duma Key

Self-made millionaire Edgar Freemantle's wife walks out on him after a construction accident leaves him disfigured, so he heads for Florida's Duma Key and starts to paint; however, his work appears to take on a life of its own.

A Thousand Tomorrows

Cody Gunner and Ali Daniels, both rodeo champions, struggle to overcome the hurts of the past and the uncertainty of the future when they meet and fall in love.

FIC KOERTGE

Deadville

While visiting an injured classmate in the hospital, sixteen-year-old Ryan, who is trying to come to terms with his sister's death from cancer, meets a young patient who claims to be able to see into the world where the dead live.

FIC LOCKHART

Dramarama

Spending their summer at Wildewood Academy, an elite boarding school for the performing arts, tests the bond between teens Sadye and her best friend Demi.

FIC MAGUIRE

Son of a Witch

Liir, believed to be the son of Elphaba the wicked witch of the West, has been spared from the destruction of Emerald City and nursed back to health at the Cloister of Saint Glinda; and when he is grown sets out to find his supposed half-sister and fulfill that last wishes of a dying princess.

FIC MANCUSI

Gamer Girl

Struggling to fit in after her parents' divorce sends her from Boston to her grandmother's house in the country, sixteen-year-old Maddy forms a manga club at school and falls in love through an online fantasy game.

FIC McMANN

Wake

Ever since she was eight years old, high school student Janie Hannagan has been uncontrollably drawn into other people's dreams, but it is not until she befriends an elderly nursing home patient and becomes involved with an enigmatic fellow-student that she discovers her true power.

FIC MOORE PERRY            Hero

Thom, the teenage son of a fallen superhero who seems to be linked to his mother's disappearance, joins the League and finds himself dealing with confusing sexual feelings for the hero Uberman while learning to use his powers and moving toward the truth about his mother's disappearance.

FIC MURAKAMI            Kafka on the Shore

Fifteen-year-old Kafka Tamura runs away from home to escape his father and find his long-lost sister and mother, drifting toward the parallel odyssey of an elderly Tokyo man named Nakata.

FIC MYRACLE            Bliss

Having grown up in a California commune, Bliss sees her aloof grandmother's Atlanta world as a foreign country, but she is determined to be nice as a freshman at an elite high school, which makes her the perfect target for Sandy, a girl obsessed with the occult.

FIC NESS            The Knife of Never Letting Go

Todd, one month away from an important birthday, learns all the tough lessons of adulthood when he is forced to flee after discovering a secret near the town where he lives.

FIC PATTERSON JAMES    The Final Warning (Maximum Ride v. 4)

While on a mission to Antarctica to save the world from global warming, fourteen-year-old Maximum Ride and the other members of the Flock--a band of genetically modified children who can fly--are pursued by their creator, the Uber-Director, who wants to auction them off to the highest bidder.

Three teens and a curator of unclassified artifacts at the British Museum match wits with a madman determined to use unorthodox methods to reanimate the dead, both humans and dinosaurs.

FIC RIPSLINGER            Last Kiss

Billy O'Reilly, a farm worker in rural Iowa, is forced to keep his relationship with Lisa a secret due to their different social standings, but when Lisa is murdered and circumstantial evidence points to Billy, he must break through the town's class barriers to prove his innocence and find the true killer.

FIC SARKAR            How to Salsa in a Sari

Issa Mazumder is shocked to learn her mother is marrying Cat Morena's father, and struggles to accept her new stepsister, who shows no respect for Issa's Indian and African-American heritage, but Issa soon learns that in order to earn Cat's respect, she must welcome Cat's traditions as well.

FIC SCHMIDT            Useful Fools

A fifteen-year-old Peruvian boy, whose mother runs a clinic for poor village children, becomes caught up in the war after Senderistas bomb the clinic, killing his mother and throwing his family into turmoil.

Hallowmere series – v. 3. Corrine and her friends travel to London, hoping to find a rathstone that will help them end the ongoing war with the Fey.

Eighteen-year-old Michael Kerrigan, writer of obituaries for the Scranton Observer and captain of the track team, is ready for the most important season of his life--until the police find four joints in his school locker, and he is faced with a choice that could change everything.

FIC WILSON MARTIN        What They Always Tell Us

Sixteen-year-old Alex feels so disconnected from his friends that he starts his junior year at a Tuscaloosa, Alabama, high school by attempting suicide, but soon, a friend of his older brother draws him into cross-country running and a new understanding of himself.
