A memoir in which writer/comedian Elna Baker describes her experiences as a single Mormon virgin looking for love in New York.

B DARWIN Heiligman [Charles and Emma](#)  
A biography of English naturalist Charles Darwin that provides an account of the personality behind evolutionary theory and the affect of his work on his personal life, such as his relationship with his religious wife.

B SHAKUR Bastfield [Back in the Day: My Life and Times with Tupac Shakur](#)  
Darrin Bastfield describes what it was like growing up with rapper Tupac Shakur, explaining why the rapper was often misunderstood and profiling his visionary efforts to unite the African-American community.

GN B SMALL Small [Stitches](#)  
*Graphic novel.* A graphic novel that chronicles the life of American author and illustrator David Small, detailing his sickly childhood and teenage years, relationship with his parents, his cancer, and more.

302.23 SCH Schepp [TV Wonderland: the Enchantment of Early Television](#)  
The Schepps walk us through the invention of TV and its subsequent replacement of the radio.

305.235 JEN Jenkins [97 Things to Do Before You Finish High School](#)  
Lists ninety-seven things for teens to do or learn before leaving high school, looking beyond school and homework to such adventures as taking a road trip, and includes tips on friendship, dating, and independence.

306.875 WEL Welch [The Kids Are All Right](#)  
The four Welch siblings--Amanda, Liz, Dan, and Diana--describe the hardships and struggles they faced during their childhoods, which culminated with the death of their actress mother, Ann, and resulted in their separation from one another.

323.4 ARE Aretha [Freedom Summer \(The Civil Rights Movement series\)](#)  
Chronicles the attempts by Civil Right's organizers across the nation to secure voting rights for African-Americans in Mississippi during the summer of 1963.

323.4 ARE Aretha [Selma and the Voting Rights Act \(The Civil Rights Movement series\)](#)  
Provides an account of the events of 1965 when civil rights activists, led by Martin Luther King, Jr., gathered in Selma, Alabama, to protest practices designed to keep African-Americans from being able to vote, and discusses how the televised violence against the activists caused widespread outrage that spurred the passage of the Voting Rights Act.

323.4 ARE Aretha [The Trial of the Scottsboro Boys \(The Civil Rights Movement series\)](#)  
Explores how the unfair trials of nine African-American men, dubbed the Scottsboro Boys, who were unjustly accused of raping and beating two white women in 1931, became a turning point in the civil rights movement and changed the American justice system for the better.

- 323.4 BOE Boerst Marching in Birmingham (The Civil Rights Movement series)  
Provides an account of the events of 1963 when civil rights leader Martin Luther King, Jr., arrived in Birmingham, Alabama, along with other leaders of the movement to protest the city's policies of racial segregation, and made the controversial decision to enlist the help of high school and elementary students in the fight for equality.
- 323.4 HOO Hoose Claudette Colvin  
Presents an account of fifteen-year-old Claudette Colvin, an African-American girl who refused to give up her seat to a white woman on a segregated bus in Montgomery, Alabama, nine months before Rosa Parks, and covers her role in a crucial civil rights case.
- 324.973 SHA Shapiro Project President: Bad Hair and Botox on the Road to the White House  
Discusses the history of the presidents' images, from George Washington to George W. Bush, as a causal factor in their election, and examines personality, clothing choices, height, hair, and other factors.
- 325.26 CAP Captive Passage  
Eight essays and 160 illustrations examine the causes, outcomes, and legacies of the 400-year slave trade, covering various aspects of the slave trade and its impact on governments, societies, economies, and families.
- 325.26 JOH Johnson Africans in America  
A historical narrative that chronicles the history of slavery in the United States from the development of slavery in the English colonies through the Civil War.
- 333.75 BJO Bjornlund Deforestation  
Presents a discussion of deforestation that examines its causes, its impact on the environment, the seriousness of the problem, and ways that it can possibly be stopped.
- 333.79 CUR Currie-McGhee Biofuels  
Presents a discussion of biofuels that examines their benefits, such as reduced dependence on fossil fuels and less negative impact on the environment, and covers the question of whether biofuels threaten the world's food supply.
- 333.79 FRI Friedman Fossil Fuels  
Presents a discussion of fossil fuels that covers questions about whether the fuels are running out and examines their threat to the environment and impact on national security, and analyzes the potential benefits of alternative energy sources.

Presents a discussion of hydrogen power that discusses developments in hydrogen vehicle technology, its positive and negative impacts on the environment, its ability to reduce dependence on foreign oil, and plans for future technological innovations.

Presents a discussion of solar power that discusses developments in photovoltaic technology, its impact on global warming, its ability to reduce dependence on foreign oil, and plans for future technological innovations.

364.1 DOB Dobyns No Angel: My Harrowing Undercover Journey to the Inner Circle of the Hells Angels

FBI agent Jay Dobyns relates his experiences working undercover to infiltrate the Hells Angel Motorcycle Club, discussing his actions and how the job nearly cost him his family and life.

364.1 SHA Shakur Monster: the Autobiography of an L. A. Gang Member

L.A. Crip gang member Kody Scott recounts his life from the time he joined at eleven years old to being in solitary confinement at San Quentin.

364.15 ARE Aretha The Murder of Emmett Till (The Civil Rights Movement series)

Chronicles the 1955 murder in Money, Mississippi, of Chicago teenager, Emmett Till, by local store owner Roy Bryant and his brother-in-law, J.W. Milam, the trial and acquittal that followed, and how the incident impacted the civil rights movement.

364.163 HAS Hastings Identity Theft, Inc.

This is the first book on the subject from the inside, told by someone who's assumed hundreds of identities and become rich off it. Not only does the author reveal how ID theft is done, he tells loads of wildly unbelievable but true stories about his impersonations as they led to riches.

371.822 MOR Mortenson Stones into Schools

Greg Mortenson describes his efforts to promote peace throughout the world, and details how he was able to establish over 130 schools--mostly for girls--in remote regions of Afghanistan and Pakistan with the backing of the Central Asia Institute--a nonprofit organization.

391.65 JOH Johnson Tattoo Machine: Tall Tales, True Stories, and My Life in Ink

Presents a memoir of the author's experiences as a tattoo artist in Portland, Oregon, covering the various types of people who come into his parlor, the inside terms of the trade, and details about running a successful business while practicing a form of art.

JAC (Jackdaw) 364.1 JAC Jack the Ripper and the Whitechapel Murders

Contains reproductions of sixteen contemporary documents related to the murders of six women in London's East End in 1888, committed by the still unidentified killer known as Jack the Ripper.

Examines the discovery of Pluto, explores its presence in American culture, and discusses the reactions of people after it was demoted from a planet to a dwarf planet.

590 CON Conniff Swimming with Piranhas at Feeding Time

Collects travel stories about the author's experience as a field naturalist in various countries while learning about turtles, tigers, ants, piranhas, and other dangerous animals.

613.69 OLL Ollestad Crazy for the Storm

A memoir discussing the author's upbringing as a young sportsman and tragic experience in a plane crash with his father, father's girlfriend, and pilot at the age of eleven, covering his lone survival of the crash and harsh conditions.

616.8589 ORF Orfalea Copy This!: How I Turned Dyslexia, ADHD, and 100 Square Feet Into a Company Called Kinko's

Tells the story of the founder of Kinko's and his struggle with ADHD and dyslexia but still managed to grow his business to a \$2 billion dollar empire.

618.92 COX Cox The Fight to Survive

Relates the true story of fourteen-year-old Elizabeth Evans Hughes, who was diagnosed with diabetes in 1918, and the efforts by researchers to discover a treatment.

621.31 KAM Kamkwamba The Boy Who Harnessed the Wind

The author details how he ignored naysayers and was able to bring electricity and running water to his Malawian village when he built a makeshift windmill out of scrap metal and spare parts.

781.65 GEL Gelly Icons of Jazz: a History in Photographs

Presents a photo portrait and biographical profile for more than eighty jazz greats from throughout the twentieth century, alphabetically arranged.

781.66 PUN Punk: the Whole Story

Discusses the history of punk, featuring the Sex Pistols, the Ramones, and the Clash, collecting articles, interviews, and photos from British magazines "Mojo," "Q," and "Sounds," and provides lists of the top twenty British punk singles and the 77 greatest albums in the genre.

Recounts the twelve-day pursuit and capture of John Wilkes Booth, covering the chase through Washington D.C., Maryland, and Virginia, with a discussion of Abraham Lincoln as a father, husband, and friend that examines the impact of his death on those close to him.

Presents black-and-white photographs of residents from the small Iowa community of Oxford, taken in 1984 and again two decades later, with accompanying first-person narratives.

FIC ASHBY Zombie Queen of Newbury High

While trying to cast a love spell on her date on the eve of the senior prom, Mia inadvertently infects her entire high school class with a virus that will turn them all into zombies.

FIC BARLOW Sharp Teeth

Dogcatcher Anthony has no idea that his girlfriend is a werewolf who has abandoned her pack, but her efforts to keep her secret lead to murderous results.

FIC BARNES Tales of the Madman Underground

Karl Shoemaker, starting his senior year in Lightsburg, Ohio in 1973, vows to break out of the therapy group he has been forced to attend during school hours and become "normal."

FIC BAZELL Beat the Reaper

Dr. Peter Brown, an intern at a Manhattan hospital, finds his past catching up with him when a patient realizes Peter is actually Pietro "Bearclaw" Brnwa, a hit man for the mob and has been in the Witness

Protection Program for years, leaving Peter scrambling to find a way to protect his patients and himself from the bloodbath that will ensue if Peter's patient reveals his true identity.

FIC BECKER Lifeblood (Darkside series book 2)

As Jonathan searches London's Darkside for the same murderer that his mother was seeking when she disappeared twelve years earlier, it becomes clear that it is Jonathan who is being hunted.

FIC BENIOFF City of Thieves

Seventeen-year-old Lev Beniov, having been arrested for looting the corpse of a German paratrooper, is given the opportunity to be released from jail if he, along with a soldier imprisoned for desertion, can secure twelve eggs to be used in the colonel's daughter's wedding cake by traversing the dangerous streets of Leningrad.

FIC BRADLEY The Sweetness at the Bottom of the Pie (A Flavia de Luce Mystery)

It's the beginning of summer in 1950 in an English village. Eleven-year-old aspiring chemist Flavia de Luce passes the time tinkering in the laboratory. When Flavia discovers a murdered stranger in the cucumber patch outside her bedroom window, she leaves her lab to solve the crime herself. Flavia takes off on her bicycle to catch a murderer.

FIC BRADLEY The Weed that Strings the Hangman's Bag (A Flavia de Luce Mystery – 2<sup>nd</sup> adventure)

Flavia de Luce, an eleven-year-old sleuth, sets aside her chemistry experiments to solve the mystery behind the death of an unfortunate puppeteer--who was electrocuted--and attempts to discover how his death is connected to a cold case that the local constables have been unable to solve.

FIC BRAY Going Bovine

Cameron Smith, a disaffected sixteen-year-old diagnosed with mad cow disease, sets off on a road trip with a death-obsessed, video-gaming dwarf he meets in the hospital in an attempt to find a cure.

FIC BROWNE Breathers

Andy Warner, a reanimated survivor of a car crash that killed his wife, pieces his life together from his parents' wine cellar while attending zombie support group meetings, and when he meets Rita, an undead girl who cut her own throat, he begins to find his place in society.

FIC BURG All the Broken Pieces

Two years after being airlifted out of Vietnam in 1975, Matt Pin is haunted by the terrible secret he left behind and, now, in a loving adoptive home in the United States, a series of profound events forces him to confront his past.

FIC CABOT Being Nikki

Studious, socially conscious Emerson Watts' brain is transplanted into teen supermodel Nikki Howard who was killed in an accident and she can't even tell her longtime crush, Christopher or her best friend who she is now.

FIC CABOT Runaway

When sixteen-year-old Emerson Watts learns the truth about Nikki, the teen supermodel into whose body Emerson's brain was transplanted, she finds that there is only one person to turn to for help--especially since her loved ones seem to be furious with her.

FIC CABOT Reunion (The Mediator series book 3)

Susannah Simon is a teenager with the ability to interact with ghosts but she'd rather just concentrate on graduating high school until the ghosts of four teenagers killed in a suspicious car accident try to take vengeance on her friend Michael.

Swim team members and best friends Matt, Sean, and Coop, set themselves the summertime goal of seeing a live girl naked, and while the chances of that happening seem very dim, Matt's personal goal to swim the one-hundred-yard butterfly to impress the new girl on the team seems even less likely to happen.

Soulless

Alexia Tarabotti, a woman without a soul who is viewed as unable to marry, works with werewolf Lord Conall Maccon to clear her name after she accidentally kills a vampire and is suspected of the disappearances of other undead members of high society.

Sixteen-year-old Zoey Redbird is just settling in at the House of Night, a finishing school dedicated to training fledgling vampires to become productive adults, when a series of murders targeting human teens is traced back to the school, forcing her to think about the connections that still exist between her old and new worlds. House of Night series - book 2.

FIC COBEN

Hold Tight

Mike and Tia Baye, worried about their sixteen-year-old son Adam, wrestle with whether to spy on his computer, and discover details about their son's friend Spencer's suicide while a killer stalks the neighborhood. *Abraham Lincoln H.S. Book Award 2011 Nominee*

FIC COEHLO

Brida

While on a quest for knowledge, Brida, a young Irish girl, encounters two individuals who teach her about magic; a forest hermit, who helps her to realize the goodness in the world, and a woman who teaches her how to dance and pray to the moon; but while this knowledge soaks in Brida struggles to balance her priorities.

Junior Thibodeau comes of age in the 1980s with the knowledge that the world will end upon his thirty-sixth year, a prophecy revealed to him in utero, which forces him to have an existential crisis while dealing with his life and family.

FIC DASHNER

The Maze Runner

Sixteen-year-old Thomas wakes up with no memory in the middle of a maze and realizes he must work with the community in which he finds himself if he is to escape.

FIC DAVIS JOYCE

Can't Stop the Shine

Sisters Kalia and Mariama Jefferson do not agree on much, but when an "American Idol" style singing competition is announced they both know Kalia should enter, not realizing the strain the contest is going to put on everyone involved.

FIC DeKEYSER

Jump the Cracks

On the way to visit her father in New York City, fifteen-year-old Victoria finds an apparently abused child in the train's bathroom and soon finds herself branded a kidnapper and on the run while trying to fulfill her promise to protect the boy at all costs.

FIC DENIRO

Total Oblivion, More or Less

Sixteen-year-old Macy has her world turned upside down when communication lines fail and a Scythian army attacks, causing her to leave her suburban Minnesota town with her family; as they plan to escape a refugee camp via the Mississippi River, events take an even stranger turn, and her family's bonds are tested.

FIC DIVINE

The Fight (Drama High series v. 1)

Sixteen-year-old Jayd Jackson is determined to start her junior year drama free, but she soon learns that life in her new predominately white high school is not the same as her tough inner city school as she tries to stop a fight that could ruin everything she has worked for.

FIC DIVINE

Frenemies (Drama High series v. 4)

African-American high school junior Jayd Jackson has to deal with more drama when her friend, Nellie, lets her homecoming princess title go to her head and her boyfriend, Jeremy, starts to act like he is no longer interested in her.

FIC DIVINE Holidaze (Drama High series v. 9)

Jayd Jackson calls upon her gifted ancestors to help her get back to normal after the death of her friend Tre.

FIC EFAW After

Devon Davenport is a straight-A student and prominent player on her school's soccer team, but when she is linked to an abandoned baby found in the trash she is accused of attempted murder.

FIC FERGUSON The Angel of Death

Seventeen-year-old high school senior Cameryn Mahoney uses skills learned as assistant to her coroner father to try to unravel the mystery of a local teacher's gruesome death, while also awaiting a possible reunion with her long-missing mother.

FIC FERGUSON The Circle of Blood

As she uses her knowledge of forensic medicine to investigate the death of a young runaway, seventeen-year-old Cameryn Mahoney, an assistant to her coroner father, worries that her secretive mother may be involved.

FIC FERRARIS Finding Nouf

The family of sixteen-year-old Nouf calls upon desert guide Nayir ash-Sharqi to investigate her disappearance; however, when her body is found in the desert and it is determined she died from drowning, Nayir teams up with lab worker Katya Hijazi to find out what really happened.

FIC FORMAN If I Stay

While in a coma following an automobile accident that killed her parents and younger brother, seventeen-year-old Mia, a gifted cellist, weighs whether to live with her grief or join her family in death.

FIC FRIESEN Jerk, California

Plagued by Tourette's syndrome and a stepfather who despises him, Sam meets an old man in his small Minnesota town who sends him on a road trip designed to help him discover the truth about his life.

FIC GERSHOW The Local News

Lydia Pasternak, a socially awkward girl who is the opposite of her missing brother Danny, reflects on her sibling's disappearance with mixed feelings as the search parties turn up nothing, and begins to obsess over her family's hired private investigator while struggling with a social world she has never before been a part of.

FIC GILES Right Behind You

After spending over four years in a mental institution for murdering a friend in Alaska, fourteen-year-old Kip begins a completely new life in Indiana with his father and stepmother under a different name, but has trouble fitting in and finds there are still problems to deal with from his childhood.

FIC GODBERSEN Envy (a Luxe series)

At the dawn of the twentieth century, several families in New York remain stunned by the antics of mischievous socialites, including Henry, Penelope, and Lina.

FIC GODBERSEN Rumors (a Luxe series)

After the death of Elizabeth Holland, all of New York speculates about her unfortunate demise and wonders what role her mischievous sister, Diana, and notorious cad Henry Schoonmaker played in the events leading up to her death.

FIC GREEN JOHN Paper Towns

High school senior Quentin Coldwater's real world never quite measures up to Fillory, the enchanted land in his favorite fantasy novels, and even an education at the mysterious Brakebills College for Magical Pedagogy leaves him without purpose, but when he discovers a way into Fillory, his life becomes a dangerous adventure.

FIC HALE                            Book of a Thousand Days

Fifteen-year-old Dashti, sworn to obey her sixteen-year-old mistress, the Lady Saren, shares Saren's years of punishment locked in a tower, then brings her safely to the lands of her true love, where both must hide who they are as they work as kitchen maids.

FIC HOBAN JULIA                Willow

Sixteen-year-old Willow, who was driving the car that killed both of her parents, copes with the pain and guilt by cutting herself, until she meets a smart and sensitive boy who is determined to help her stop.

FIC HOLDER                        Pretty Little Devils

Life seems rosy for the Pretty Little Devils, the most popular girls' clique in high school, until its members begin to experience threats and assaults.

FIC HOPKINS ELLEN              Tricks

Collection of five stories about three girls and two boys who question how they feel about themselves while learning about love and sexuality.

FIC JORDAN                        Mudbound

The shaky marriage between Henry McAllan and his city-bred wife Laura becomes even more unstable when his brother Jamie returns from World War II in 1946 to help work the family's miserable cotton farm in the Mississippi Delta, along with his comrade-in-arms Ronsel Jackson, the oldest son of local sharecroppers, who soon learns that his heroics in battle mean nothing in the Jim Crow south.

FIC KING STEPHEN               The Dead Zone

An accident has left John Smith in a coma for four years. When he awakens, he finds he is able to discern information about others simply by touching them.

FIC KING STEPHEN               Dreamcatcher

Four friends' association with a mentally handicapped boy with supernatural abilities leaves them with special gifts that come in handy when they unite as adults for an annual hunting trip in Maine and find themselves in the middle of an alien invasion.

FIC KING STEPHEN               Just After Sunset

Twelve short stories by Stephen King on the theme of relationships, including new stories and previously released material such as "The Gingerbread Girl," "The Things They Left Behind," and "The Cat from Hell."

FIC KING STEPHEN               Wizard and Glass (Dark Tower series book 4)

Roland and his band have narrowly escaped the city of Lud and boarded Blaine, a train that will take them to, of all places, Kansas, where the ghost city of Topeka has been depopulated by a superflu and where, an emerald palace rises enchantingly. Before Roland and the companions of his ka-tet continue along the Path of the Bean, Roland must tell his companions the tale that defines him both as a man and hero, a long-ago romance of witchery and evil, of the beautiful, unforgettable Susan Delgado, of the Big Coffin Hunters and Reah of the Coos. And when his tale is finished, Roland confronts a man who goes by many names, and who perhaps holds the key to the Dark Tower.

FIC KING STEPHEN               Wolves of the Calla (Dark Tower series book 5)

Roland and his ka-tet aid a quiet ranching community bracing itself for an attack by the Wolves of Thunderclap, who, every twenty-odd years, abduct one of each of their twin children and return them physically and mentally disabled; meanwhile, a single red rose of great portent is threatened in a vacant lot in Manhattan.

FIC KITAMURA                    The Long Shot  
 Cal, a veteran mixed martial arts fighter who is trying to make a comeback, and Riley, his longtime trainer, are headed to Mexico for a rematch with the legendary champion, Rivera.

FIC KNOWLES                    Lessons from a Dead Girl  
 Laine struggles to come to terms with her friendship with troubled Leah Greene, whose secrets were too much for Laine to bear and whose actions sent Laine on a painful journey of self-discovery.

FIC LaCOUR                    Hold Still  
 Caitlin wrestles with her feelings of devastation and helplessness after her friend Ingrid commits suicide, and she turns to her family and newfound friends for help while encountering love, broadening her horizons, and using Ingrid's journal to heal.

FIC LARBALESTIER            Liar  
 Compulsive liar Micah promises to tell the truth after revealing that her boyfriend has been murdered.

FIC LLOYD                    The Carbon Diaries 2015

 Indigo Summer and her boyfriend Marcus Carter decide to see other people while they are on summer vacation, but when Indigo gets in over her head while staying with her independent cousin, she knows Marcus is the only person who can help her.

American Rust

Billy Poe and Isaac English, two friends in Buell, a struggling steel town in Pennsylvania, plan to escape to California, but when Isaac accidentally kills a transient, other complications arise that strain their friendship while Poe's mother, Grace, pines for the local sheriff. *Summer Reading 2010 – Jr. English*

All We Know of Heaven
