ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP GRANT

The RBEA has established academic scholarship grants of at least \$500.00 to be awarded to seniors graduating in January or June 2011. This year's scholarships will be considered on the basis of academic achievement, and involvement in the school, and community. The committee will carefully consider the student's essay and recommendations.

ELIGIBILITY:

- I. Each senior candidate must meet the following criteria:
 - A. Complete all course work for graduation by June 2011.
 - B. Has earned a minimum of (8) credits of total course work at R.B.
 - C. Rank in the upper 20% of the senior class at the end of seventh semester.
 - D. Must be tentatively accepted by a college/university for spring or fall of 2011 admission.

- II. Responsibilities of the candidate: All must be completed to be considered.
 - A. Complete an application including a brief summary of your (college and career) goals.
 - B. Write an essay (two paragraphs minimum) that explains why you should be considered as a candidate for this scholarship, focusing on your academic interests and school or community involvement.
 - C. Submit recommendations from two R-B certified faculty (Administrators, teachers, counselors).
 - D. Candidate should check with the R-B faculty member for permission to use a recommendation. Do not use a recommendation from an RBEA Scholarship Committee Member. (Mrs. Dunn, Mr. Fields, Mr. Monti, Mr. Franko).
 - E. Submit a letter of recommendation from a **non-R B staff member** (not related to the candidate). Example: employer, supervisor of volunteer work, clergyman, etc.

- III. Completed application **must be typed** and returned to the Student Services Office by April 15, 2011. These materials will be photocopied. Make sure that they are clear and dark. Students may use these forms or attach computer generated letters of recommendation or student essays.

- IV. Finalists may be asked to participate in an interview with the RBEA scholarship committee.
