Riverside Brookfield High School
Outstanding Community Service Recognition Award

The Rotary Club will recognize *two* graduating seniors from Riverside Brookfield High School who have demonstrated during their high school career an outstanding level of community service activity. Hours of services to the school, through the school organizations and school-sponsored activities, and hours of service given in the community through religious, fraternal, and civic organizations will all be considered in the determination of these four awards (one time awards of \$750 ea.).

Criteria:

1. The recipients will be a graduating member of the senior class, in good standing, with a grade point average of at least 2.5 (4.0 scale).
2. The recipient will have demonstrated an outstanding and exceptional amount of community service through both school service projects and community-based service projects and organizations.
3. In general, rotary shall define “community service” for the purposes of this award in the same manner as it is defined for Riverside Brookfield High School service requirement. While all community service should be verifiable, documentation of service hours for this award need not be as stringent as it is for the graduation requirement.
4. The recipient will have demonstrated leadership qualities by serving in a leadership or coordinating capacity for one or more of the community service projects they engage in.
5. In general, the club would prefer to recognize a student who has consistently given time to school service and community service projects throughout their high school years over a student who has given a large number of hours to a single service project or event.

Procedure:

1. For the Rotary Award, applicants will also be asked to complete the application form attached to this notification.
2. Applications should be submitted to: Riverside Brookfield High School Student Services by April 16, 2010.
3. Applicants may be asked to meet with a sub-committee from Brookfield-Riverside Rotary Club.
4. The scholarship will be presented at the Awards Recognition Ceremony, May 26, 2010.
