

AARON SEMENSKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP GRANT

The Aaron Semenske Scholarship Foundation will award a renewable \$2000.00 academic scholarship grant to one senior male or female student/athlete graduating from Riverside Brookfield High School in June, 2011. The scholarship will be considered on the basis of academic achievement, athletic participation, involvement in community and/or religious groups, and demonstrated leadership in the community, the classroom and on the athletic field. These are the qualities that Aaron Semenske displayed as captain of three sports and highest-ranking student of the RB class of 1996.

ELIGIBILITY:

I. Each senior applicant should meet the following criteria

- A. Complete all course work for graduation in June 2011.
- B. Have been enrolled in RB for the entire Junior and Senior years.
- C. Be in the upper 25% of the senior class academically at the end of 7 semesters.
- D. Earned a varsity letter in at least 2 sports.
- E. Must be accepted at a 4 year college or university for the fall of 2011.
- F. Give evidence of leadership activities.
- G. Give evidence of demonstrated community service.
- H. Follow the guidelines of the Athletic Code of Conduct

II. Responsibility of the Applicant.

- A. Complete and return an application to Student Services by April 15, 2011.
- B. Submit a written recommendation by an RB faculty member or counselor with emphasis on leadership displayed by the applicant in the classroom.
- C. Submit a written recommendation by an RB Varsity Coach with emphasis on leadership displayed by the applicant in practice and competition.
- D. Submit a written recommendation by a religious, community or school leader with emphasis on leadership and service displayed by the applicant that benefited the community.
