

STEVEN DUVE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

- What is the award? A one-time \$750 award given to a student who meets the qualifications listed below based upon athletic participation, academics, and a short essay.
- Who was Steven Duve? Steven was a 1983 graduate of RBHS and was an advocate for nature conservation while environmentalism was still in its infancy. At RBHS, he was an honor student who still found time to participate and excel in 3 sports during his 4 years. In 1987, Steven died in a car accident while he was returning to his college dorm after a day of hiking.
- Qualifications: The candidate:
- i. Should have participated on at least 2 sports teams in 3 of their 4 years while in high school.
 - ii. Must have applied to attend a college or university.
 - iii. Must have at least a 3.25GPA (weighted)
 - iv. Must submit an essay of approximately 1000 words (or less) on the following:
 - a. Describe your experience with balancing athletics and academics.
 - b. Describe how nature, or the environment, has affected your life or how it may affect you in the future.
 - c. Please list your name and the college/university you are attending or if still undecided, where you applied to in the essay heading.

NOTE: the application and essay are due by April 15th to the Student Services Department.
