From 140 contemporary poets, many of whom have never been published, Naomi Shihab Nye gathers observations, ruminations, and informal prose comments on the theme of loss: from clothing or a thought, to deaths of friends and family members, of innocence, time, opportunities, pride, a homeland. The selections are all free verse, direct of address, virtually free of obscure imagery or difficult language, most, but not all, originally written in English. This is heavy reading, but it documents a universal experience in ways that are thought- provoking.. –Kirkus Reviews
